

### **NC Green Schools Application for Recognition Instructions**

**GOAL:** To recognize North Carolina PK-12 public and private schools that engage in sustainability in 5 designated areas.

#### **ELIGIBILITY:**

- All public and private PK-12 schools in North Carolina
- All activities described in the application should reflect projects that are ongoing or will occur during the current school year.
- Applications must be received by May 5 at midnight.

#### INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLICATION: -

- A PDF and 5 high resolution photos will be submitted on-line to the NC Green Schools Program. Schools should send all information to <a href="mailto:info@ncgreenschools.org">info@ncgreenschools.org</a> and confirm receipt of the application.
- Please use 12 pt font and 1 inch margins for all narratives.
- Only complete applications submitted on time will be considered.
- Applications should be organized in the provided format and contain the following parts:

### 1. PDF entitled, "Your School Name NC Green Schools Application Submission Date" includes:

### Part A - Cover Sheet: Administrator Image Release Statement, and Key Signatures

The Cover Sheet (page 2) must be completed and signed by the principal, two lead teachers, and the PTO/PTA president.

### Part B – Summary of Green School Activities

This is a stand-alone summary that should provide a concise and coherent snapshot of how your school addresses each of the Rubric components (400 word maximum).

#### Part C – Narrative Summary and Documentation

To be eligible for the Green School Recognition, your school **must demonstrate** how it has addressed **each** component (at least 3 out of 5). A narrative summary (800 word max/component) and supporting documentation is required for each indicator. See page 3 for guidelines for supporting documentation.

#### Part D – Rubric Submission Form (Page 6)

Each school will evaluate its success in all rubric areas. Applicants must submit a Rubric Submission Form with completed points in each rubric component and totals for final submission to be a NC Green School (Must score in 3 out of 5 components minimum). May use worksheets provided. See Page 6.

Part E – Power Point Presentation with 5 Photos
All applicants must submit a power point with five high resolution photos with titles/captions
(Minimum: 300KB each; Best if 1KB each). Each photo should represent one component of
the Green Schools Rubric. These photos will be used for public relations purposes in various
media for the Green Schools Recognition Program. Do not include names of students.

#### PART B: SUMMARY OF GREEN SCHOOL HIGHLIGHTS

Please provide a concise (400 word max) summary that describes how your school is representative of a Green School. Focus on what your school has accomplished in each of the Green Schools Rubric components. Describe what makes your school unique and successful in efforts to be sustainable. Also, be sure to describe the level of student involvement in projects and the involvement of the Green Team.

This summary provides the judges with highlights to your Green School accomplishments. This information will also be used as public information via the NC Green Schools website. It should be written as a stand-alone summary, in third person, and submitted as part of the one PDF application file.

#### PART C: NARRATIVE SUMMARY AND DOCUMENTATION

For this part of the application, applicants address current activities, improvements to ongoing activities, and/or new projects for the current school year. Indicators (at least 1) from each component should be addressed within the narrative summary **immediately** followed by supportive documentation. See the rubric worksheet for all indicators within each component.

Part C must be submitted as part of the one PDF application file.

Part C should be organized and submitted as follows. Each section I.- IV. should include a Narrative Summary (800 word max) including Indicator categories and Documentation (up to 8 pages). The Innovation section (V) will be considerably less in length (400 words max and up to 4 pages of documentation).

- I. Culture and Community
- II. School Sustainability
- III. Healthy Schools
- IV. Curriculum Integration
- V. Innovation

Documentation may include, but is not limited to:

- Captioned photographs (please do NOT include student names)
- Lesson plans
- Agendas from workshops and meetings
- Powerpoint presentations
- Letters of intent or commitment from community partners
- Records of related community service hours
- Newspaper articles
- School newsletters

### PART D: RUBRIC SUBMISSION FORM

Each school will evaluate its success in all rubric areas. Applicants must submit a Rubric Submission Form with completed points in each rubric component and totals for final submission to be recognized as a NC Green School (Must score in 3 out of 5 components minimum). Use the worksheets online to assess your school's progress and then fill out Part D with the totals.

### PART E: POWER POINT with 5 PHOTO .jpg FILES

Applicants must submit a power point with **five high resolution photos with titles/captions** (Minimum: 300KB each; Best if 1KB each)— preferably one photo representing each component of the Green Schools Rubric. Include photos in one Power Point presentation. These photos will be used for public relations purposes in various media for the Green Schools Recognition Program and have been approved by School Administrator for use in this context (Part A: Image Release Statement).
