


FROM EAST AND NORTHEAST:

Take I-85 South to exit 76 (Salisbury, Catawba College). Bear right at end of exit ramp onto Innes Street. Drive straight through downtown, continuing approximately 3 miles to campus.

FROM WEST AND NORTHWEST:

Take I-40 East to Statesville and the intersection with I-77 South. After a brief distance, leave I-77 South at exit 49-A (Garner-Bagnal Boulevard), and turn right at the end of exit ramp onto Highway 70 East. Continue for approximately 30 miles. In Salisbury, 70 East becomes Statesville Blvd. Continue straight on Statesville Blvd., approximately 3 miles. Turn left onto Innes St. to the campus.

FROM SOUTH:

Take I-85 North to exit 76 (Salisbury, Catawba College). Bear left at the light at end of ramp onto Innes Street. Drive straight through downtown, continuing approximately 3 miles to campus.
