Welcome to Catawba College. During your visit to the campus, the athletic training rooms and all equipment are at your disposal. A certified athletic trainer will be in attendance at all home varsity events. If numerous home events are on-going simultaneously, the high risk sport will have direct coverage and on-call communication will be available for the lower risk venues. The John Coble Athletic Training Room is located in the Abernethy Physical Education Center (ground floor). This facility will take care of athletes participating in volleyball, cross-country, men's/women's basketball, swimming, baseball, men's/women's tennis and men's/women's golf. The Lamar Dorton Athletic Training Room is located in the Hayes Center. This facility will serve athletes participating in football, field hockey, men's/women's soccer, softball and lacrosse. Visiting teams will be dressing in both facilities, so please check with your travel coordinator prior to arrival. Please note that Catawba College does NOT provide soap or towels to visiting teams. Modality use by non-certified athletic trainers is prohibited unless accompanied by a letter or prescription. If your team needs to be taped please send the supplies with them. 1. One 6 ½ or 10 gallon cooler of water on sideline.
2. 1 sleeve of drinking cups and a biohazard container on sideline.
3. One cooler of ice and bags on sideline.
4. Emergency equipment/splints etc. either on-site or in the athletic training room.
5. Athletic Training Room opens up 60-90 minutes prior to start of event.
6. Quick emergency care/treatment such as x-rays, suturing etc. can be performed at ROMedical Center located 7 minutes from campus
7. Rowan Regional Medical Center/Hospital is 4 minutes from campus.
