



**HES PAYMENT PLAN POLICY**

Registration at Catawba College requires students to acknowledge the following financial responsibility statement: "I accept responsibility for payment of my term tuition and fees by the published deadline. I understand any balance on my student account is defined as an educational loan. I understand that if I do not pay my tuition and fees or do not pay these fees by the due date, my records will be put on hold, my account will be referred to a collection agency, and I may incur other financial consequences."

Refunds will not be issued while on the HES Payment Plan, unless a true credit is present.

There is also the acknowledgement that if the student is dropped from the HES Payment Plan, either from termination (not paying) or cancellation (by will), then the balance is due immediately. Fifteen (15) days will be permitted to provide us with the remaining balance or the student is subject to financial withdrawal (removed from courses with fees still due). The signature below is an understanding of the contract and agreement to abide with all terms.
