

How-To Connect to Wi-Fi on Mobile Device

The below will provide information for connecting your mobile device to the secure wi-fi network.

Apple iOS Device (iPhone, iPod, iPad)

1. Tap the settings APP
2. Tap Wi-Fi. If it is not turned on, slide the Wi-Fi to the ON position.
3. In the "Choose a Network..." section, select catuskynet2
4. Enter your Catawba Username and Password
5. You may be prompted to accept a security certificate. If so, tap ACCEPT.

Android Device

1. Open the settings menu
2. Tap Wireless & Network
3. Tap Wi-Fi Settings
4. If the Wi-Fi is not turned on, please tap the check box to turn it on
5. In the "Detected Networks" section, select catuskynet2
6. When prompted to connect to catuskynet2, tap YES
7. Ensure the below settings are set for the network:
 - a. EAP Method – PEAP
 - b. PHASE 2 authentication – MSCHAPV2
 - c. Identity – this is your Catawba Username
 - d. Anonymous identity – leave this blank
 - e. Key(Passphrase) – this is your Catawba Password
8. Upon entering the information in step 7, your device should now say "connected" under the catuskynet2 network

NOTE: You must be running Firmware Version 2.2 or greater to connect to catuskynet2. To check the version of firmware, open the settings menu, scroll down and tap "About Phone", and scroll down to Firmware Version. This must be at least 2.2. Versions less than 2.2 will not work.

Windows 7 Phone

1. Tap right arrow on the Home Screen
2. Tap the Settings item
3. Tap the Wi-fi item
4. In the list of available networks, tap catuskynet2
5. Enter your Catawba username
6. Enter your Catawba password
7. Tap done

Blackberry

Blackberry devices are currently not able to connect to the Catawba Wi-Fi network due to the Blackberry (RIM) technology.
